How To Write A Queries

Information to include:

- Start with a list of surnames involved
- Then a statement of the information wanted
- Follow by detailed names, dates, and places of family members
- End with your name and contact information

Example Queries

SMITH-Seeking parents of John Q. Smith, b. 1823 in England. He lived in Chatham Co. Georgia in 1850 and Phillips Co., AR in 1860. His wife was Mary, b. 1826 in Alabama. Three known children were Bill, b. 1845 in Georgia, Sarah, b. 1848 in Georgia, and Frank Edward, b. 1861 in Arkansas. *Linda Brown, 1 Elm St., Little Rock, AR 72000, lbrown@example.com.*

MARTIN-JACKSON-Trying to prove that Richard Martin, b. 1807 in Mississippi, is the father of Betty Jackson, b. 1831 in Mississippi. Both moved to White Co. Arkansas before the 1850 census. Richard was married to Emily, b. 1809 in Alabama. Betty married Joseph Jackson, b. 1828 in Arkansas, and had two children, Richard, b. 1849 in Arkansas, and Patricia Ann, b. 1851 in Arkansas. Family legend is that her son, Richard, was named after Betty's father. *Jessica Harris, 1 Pine St., Little Rock, AR 72000, jharris@example.com.*

GREEN-MILLER-Seeking family members of Tom Green b. 1825 in Arkansas, who may have been enslaved by the William Miller family in Lonoke Co, Arkansas. Tom owned land in the 1870 census in Lonoke Co and was married to Martha b. 1835 in Arkansas. *Nancy Davis, 1 Oak St., Little Rock, AR 72000, ndavis@example.com.*

CLARK-Seeking descendants of Richard and Sandra Clark that are willing to take DNA tests. Richard (1891-1951) and Sandra (1895-1961) apparently lived their whole lives in Faulkner Co. Arkansas.
